- Never stopped since 2015

















Then, I decided to go outside






#### As a toy photographer, you spend a lot of time on the ground



What is the worst enemy of a Toy Photographer? (especially outdoor)







Tools to maintain a character stable facing the elements:

A third point of contact with the ground



- A cane

A broom



Tools to maintain a character stable facing the elements:

Some adhesive putty (like Blu-Tack, Patafix or chewing-gum!!)





Good with smooth surfaces like rocks or pavement.

Does not work with wet surfaces, sand or soil.

Tools to maintain a character stable facing the elements:

 A lightsaber hilt under the minifigure foot (soft surfaces like moss, sand or soil)



Or simply blu-tack your minifgure to a window


